

Volunteer Role	# of Roles	Certificate/Training required	Description
<b><i>Para Race Support at our mountain</i></b>			
Timer	1	Licensed Alpine Official <sup>1</sup> - Timer	Setups the electronic timing system. Synchs timing with Hand Timers. Manages the timing process for the entire race. Ensures timing results are properly recorded and reported to the US Ski Association.
Assistant Timer	1		
Start Referee	1	Licensed Alpine Official <sup>1</sup> - Judge or Referee	Manages the Start Area. Ensures the start process is properly executed. Ensures & records that racers start in the order of their bib numbers. Closes race as required and restarts the race as required. Ensures all racers follow equipment guidelines. Reports during the race to the Technical Delegate.
Finish Referee	1		Manages the Finish Area. Ensures the finish area is safe. Monitors & records that racers properly pass the finish line. Reports during the race to the Technical Delegate.
Starter	1	None	Executes start procedure for each racer. Stays in contact with the timing team.
Assistant Starter	1	None	Supports the start process by ligning up racers according to their bib number.
Hand Timer Start	1	None	Stops start time for each racer
Assistant Hand Timer Start	1	None	Records start time for each racer
Hand Timer Finish	1	None	Stops finish time for each racer who passes finish line
Assistant Hand Timer Finish	1	None	Records finish time

Chief Gate Judge	1	Experienced Gate Judge	Positions and manages the gate judges across the race hill. Collects frequent updates from gate judges.
Gate Judge	Multiple	Gate Judge Training <sup>2</sup> (SRRC or online at Para)	Monitors a set of gates to ensure the racer passes in line with the regulation. Records proper passing. Record failures.
Announcer	1	None	Announce racers, start of racers, finish time or racers.
Scoreboard Writer	Multiple	None	Records times on a scoreboard that is accessible by all viewers and racers.
Bib Collector	1	None	Collects bibs at the end of the 2nd run
Data Management	Multiple	None	Supports the registration process, creation of start lists, assignment of bib numbers to racers, sorting of bibs for each team.
Breakfast Support	Multiple	None	Provide breakfast components for the breakfast for the coaches, officials, and race volunteers.
Lunch Support	Multiple	None	Provide lunch components for the breakfast for the coaches, officials, and race volunteers.
Forerunner	3	None	Registered ski racer that is approved by the Head Coach to be a forerunner. Runs the course and reports their point of view to the Chief of Race and Technical Delegate.

Assistant Starter	1	None	Same as above
Chief Gate Judge	1	Experienced Gate Judge	Same as above

Gate Judge	Multiple	Gate Judge Training <sup>2</sup> (SRRC, online at Para)	Same as above

Parent Coordinator	2	None	Be the liaison between the Head Coach and the Parents. Support the coordination of volunteers for the Club and Para races at Roundtop. Support the ongoing communication between the Head Coach and the Parents.
Fundraising Support	3-4	None	Support fundraising activities of the Club by signing up sponsors and supporters for our races.
Annual Used Equipment Sale Event	Many	None	Support the annual equipment sale at the Lodge of Roundtop. Roles include setting the event up, cashier, sales support, security & coordination.
